Date	Event	Description of Event
March 15 <sup>th</sup> , 2018	Team-Building Day at Haddonfield Middle School	Upperclassmen Peer Leaders visit HMS – Peer Leaders organize and facilitate activities for 8 <sup>th</sup> -grade students.

Prior to September 5 <sup>th</sup>	Freshman and New Student Orientation	An enjoyable event for all students who are new to HMHS – tours around the building will be provided, meet/greet session with assigned Peer Leaders for their Freshman Orientation class for the 2018-2019 school year, and become acclimated with the climate and culture of the high school community.
